

## For Our Guests: Today's Worship

**Singing:** We sing a cappella (without any instruments). The songs are listed in the bulletin and lyrics are projected with the number from the hymnal on each slide. We encourage you to join in, but do not feel obligated.

**Lord's Supper:** Communion is a part of our worship each week. This is a celebration of Jesus' death for our sins. In this simple memorial we remember Jesus' sacrifice, and we also emphasize the central place of His cross in our faith.

**Offering:** The work at our congregation is supported by the free-will offerings of our members. You are not expected to make a donation but you may do so if you desire.

**Preaching:** The sermon will be about 25 minutes long and centered in Scripture. If our study raises questions, please feel free to ask the minister. Our LIFE Groups, listed in this bulletin, are available for anyone to attend. The scripture studied today will be discussed in a small group setting. At the conclusion of the sermon, everyone is invited to share a prayer request or be baptized. At this time, we will stand and sing, please don't feel uncomfortable: you will not be singled out in any way.

**Kingdom Kids:** At some point during the worship, usually before the sermon, children ages 3 to 4<sup>th</sup> grade will be invited to attend Kingdom Kids for a special lesson. An attended nursery is also provided downstairs.
