## Our Spiritual Diet

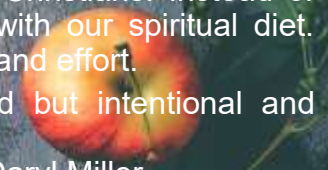
*When Your words came, I ate them; they were my joy and my heart's delight (Jeremiah 15:16a)*

Children sometimes seem uninterested in eating or desire to eat foods that fail to give them the necessary nutrients to grow stronger. Even when they do feel hungry, they always don't want to take the time to eat or will frequently make poor food choices.

Often Christians act like children. Just as food is needed for physical strength, spiritual food is needed for spiritual strength. Too often our spiritual diet is absent all together or is haphazard and lacks the spiritual nutrients needed to grow stronger. Only when we are intentional in what we feed ourselves spiritually can we achieve spiritual strength and health. This can involve forcing ourselves to feed on God's Word, scheduling time to prayer, or cultivating relationships with other Christians. Instead of acting like children with poor eating habits, we need to make wise choices with our spiritual diet. Developing a strong faith doesn't happen automatically. It takes purposeful time and effort.

So, what are you feeding yourself spiritually? Make sure it isn't haphazard but intentional and balanced. A healthy spiritual diet takes work but is well worth it.
