## MOM'S SCRAPBOOK

On my 50th birthday, as a gift, my mom made me a scrapbook of my life. This scrapbook is actually four volumes that are each 12 x 12 and about 4 inches thick. It contains pictures of my parents before I was born, my early report cards, my early artwork from school, birthday celebrations, family vacations, and countless other things that are fading memories of my past. The fact that mom saved all these memories and put them together for me speaks of her love and heart as a mother.

In Luke 2, at Jesus' birth, the angels celebrated the birth and "Mary [Jesus' mother] treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart" (verse 19). Later on, as twelve-year-old Jesus is in the temple, we read that again "his mother treasured all these things in her heart" (Luke 2:51). In a sense, Mary was working on her scrapbook of Jesus—in her heart.

There seems to be a natural tendency a mother has for her child that cherishes memories and loves in a very special way. In contrast, Ephesians 6:4 warns fathers not to "exasperate" [provoke, annoy, be overly harsh with], their children. Mothers are not given that warning. Moms tend to have a special love. Moms comprehend real love in a way that we all can learn from.

As we celebrate mothers this year, I want to encourage you to thank your mom for her love. If she has already passed, thank God for her love. If she is alive, you might even want to pull out some old pictures and reminisce of that love. Ask her to share from the scrapbook of her heart her memories of motherhood so you can see this special love.

To you mothers, thank you for your love which impacts not only your children but is a model of love for all of us. Your love shows us how to love in real, genuine ways. You may not be a master scrapbooker like my mom, but you are a scrapbooker of the heart. This type of love is worth pursuing and understanding. As we grow in our understanding of love, we grow closer to God because He Himself is love (1 John 4:8). Thanks moms! Happy Mother's Day!
